CONTEXT

Purpose

To inform, to discuss controversial issues and entertain

Example Audience

Radio audience – often a specific market segment e.g. BBC Radio 4 http://www.bbc.co.uk/radio/

Language

Written **transcript** of spoken language Level of **formality** will depend on contextual factors such as topic, speaker and radio station

FORMAT

- question-answer pattern
- more **open** questions than closed
- modality in asking questions e.g. "Do you think fathers ----" " Should families ----"
- introduction of the guest by the radio host
- transition strategies when switching aspects of a topic
- conclusion by the radio host

EXAMPLE TASK

Based on "Throw Away Daughter." A local radio station interviews Jane Parker about her experience of going to China to collect her adopted baby daughter. Write THE INTERVIEW.
